RESERVATIONS

Upon booking, a 50% deposit is due within 7 days. The balance of your fees are due upon arrival. If a deposit is not received, the dates are cancelled. **ALL deposits/payments are non-refundable, but FULLY transferable to another date.**

Guests are asked to check in no earlier than 1:00 p.m. on the day their hunt is to begin. Typically, guests check out on their last hunt day after a morning hunt and lunch.





DEER The lowcountry of South Carolina is blessed with very high deer density. Deer hunting is done from safe and comfortable welded steel tower stands, situated in a variety of habitats ranging from cutovers to river bottomlands.

- Hunters may harvest 2 bucks, 2 hogs and 1 doe per day.
- Stand placements offer shots that range from 50 400 yards. The average shot is 125 yards.



HOG We hunt free ranging wild hogs on two miles of pristine bottomland along the Savannah River. This provides an exciting experience filled with spectacular scenery. Hog hunting is a year round hunting opportunity.

- Day hunters may harvest 2 hogs per day.
- Night hunters may harvest 1 hog per night.



ALLIGATOR Imagine an evening boat ride in search of an American alligator. Very few hunting experiences can be said to be as exciting as an alligator hunt.

- Hunters may combine deer, turkey, and hog with alligator hunting.
- Alligator hunts take place during public and private land seasons on both river and pond settings all around South Carolina's lowcountry region.



TURKEY Guests enjoy an exciting morning and afternoon turkey hunting with an expert guide or can try to outwit a gobbler on their own.

 Hunters may harvest 1 gobbler per day and a maximum of 2 per season, with only 1 gobbler being harvested in March.
